
Phishing is a big problem


Easy to spot? They're getting better. Here's one we received recently:

The best behavioural scientists are still working on that one; however, we've got an answer that's a bit different to everyone elses.


How about we remove the problem rather than trying to treat the symptom.

Symptom: People enter credentials into a spoofed website

Problem: The user has and knows credential that they can give away which work in isolation
